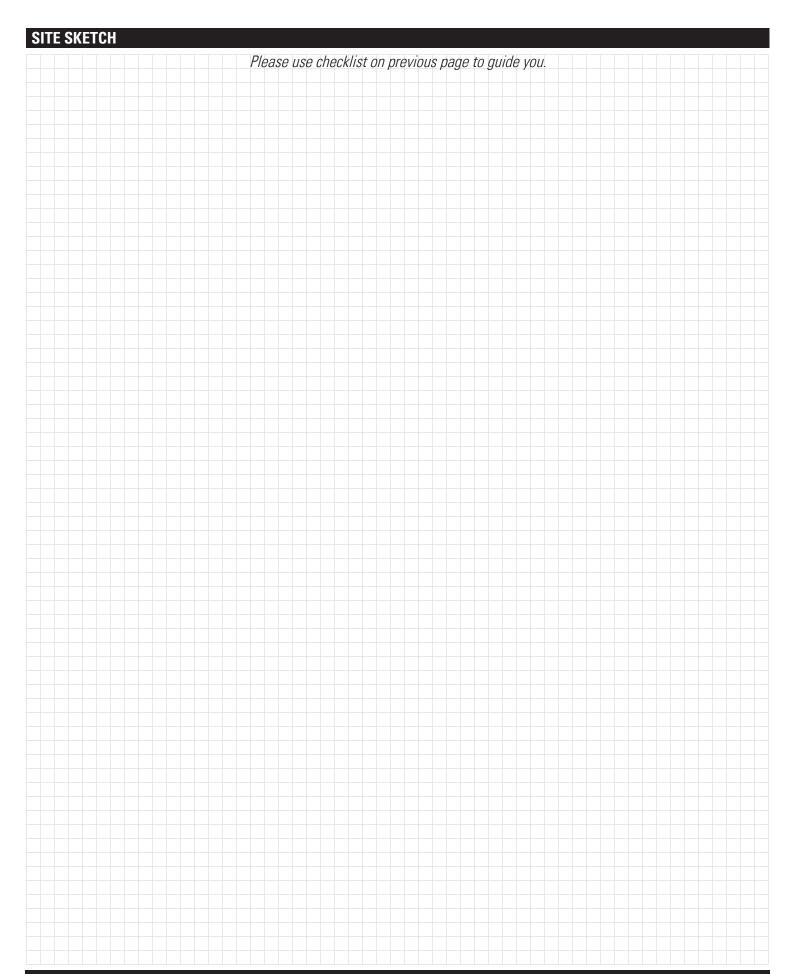

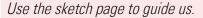

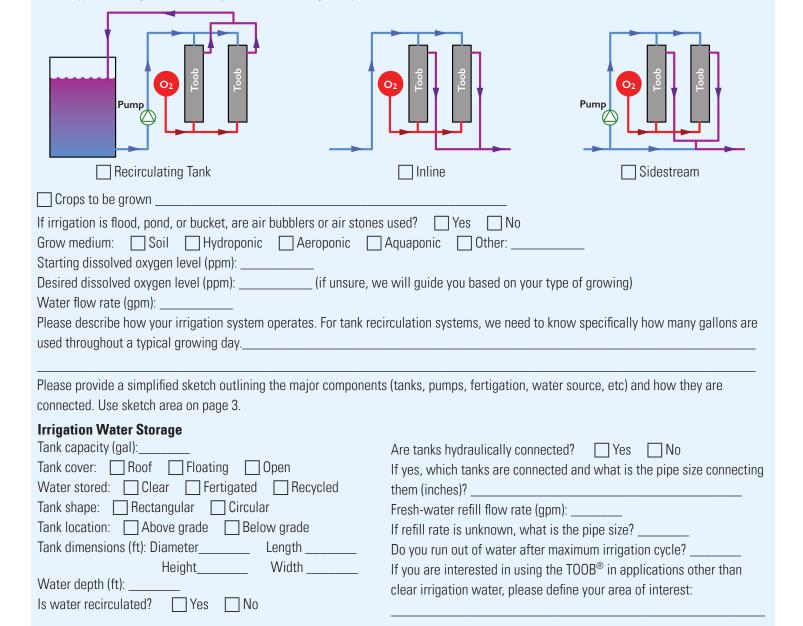


Subirrigation Floor System

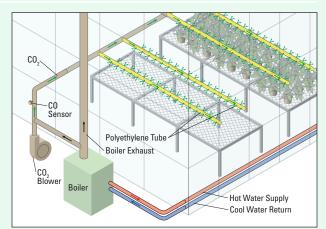
